From Steve Simoes, VT DEC on the definition of tanks and containers:

In 2010 Vermont DEC dealt with a storage facility permit for ENPRO Services of Vermont (EVI). EVI proposed placing two 1,000-gallon poly "storage devices" in the facility for managing certain state-listed aqueous wastes. I say "storage devices" because EVI initially thought of them as "containers" while we considered them "tanks." In the end, because the devices were not designed/intended for over-the-road transport when full, DEC addressed them in the permit as tanks.
