

#### But Why?

Saves valuable resources

Reduces GHG emissions. By an est. 37% in VT

Supports green jobs, new markets and businesses

Preserves landfill capacity

Improves environmental health

#### 2012 – BIG year for Vermont

Universal Recycling (Act 148) passes unanimously

Hey, you can compost that!



That's recyclable!

#### **State Organics Bans**

CA Jan. 2016 – 8-cu.yd. With increasing organics targets

**CT** Jan. 2014 – 2-ton w/in 20 miles. 2020 1-ton w/in 20 miles.

MA Oct. 2014 – 1-ton regardless of distance.

**RI** Jan. 2016 – 2-ton w/in 15 miles.

VT July 2014 – 2-ton w/in 20 miles. Phases to full ban in 2020.





### And.....It's Working

Trash (MSW) decreased 8.5% (2014 vs. 2016)

Recycling & Composting rate increased 3% (33% to 36%)

Food rescue more than doubled

99% of transfer stations have food scrap drop-off

### Benefits of Keeping Food Waste out of the Landfill







#### Feeds People

Rescued food donations more than doubled from 2014 to 2016 at the Vermont Foodbank.



VT landfills ~60,000 tons of food scraps each year.



Composting the scraps



instead of trashing them would...

reduce greenhouse gas emissions



as much as not driving ~84 million miles.

That's like driving around Earth 3,373 times!
