2007-2009 Results Report

- First draft circulated to P2 Results Task Force in August 2011
- Second draft circulated February 2012
- Final report expected to be released in April 2012
- Marketing plan

2007 - 2009 P2 Results

- Input from over 80 organizations:
 - State Environmental and Health Departments
 - Technical Assistance Programs
 - Small Business Development Centers
 - Universities and Colleges
 - Tribal Governments
 - Local Governments
 - Federal Agencies



Activity Results (Highlights)

2007-9

- 66,000 people trained in P2
- 9,500 site visits (30,000 hours)
- 10,000,000 web site visitors
 - (50% from outside the US)
- 1,000 awards
- 1,500 leadership programs
- 2,000 documents developed
- 380,000 documents distributed



Behavior Change (Highlights) 2007-9

85,000 people trained in P2 (150,000 total)

1,200 organizations developed EMS

1,500 organizations improved compliance

6,000 organizations implemented a P2 action



Outcome Results (Highlights) 2007-9

Avoided, Eliminated or Reduced:

- 400 million pounds of non-hazardous materials
- 280 million pounds of hazardous materials
- 1.2 billion pounds of hazardous waste
- 850 million pounds of air pollutants
- 4.5 billion pounds of solid waste





Outcome Results (Highlights) 2007-9

Conserved or Reduced

- 2.5 Billion kWh or electricity
- 125 Million therms of Natural Gas
- 7 Billion tons of Coal
- 360 Million kWh of other fuels
- 37 Million miles of vehicle travel



Outcome Results (Highlights) 2007-9

Generated or Purchased

- 3.3 Million kWh of Solar Energy
- 1 Million kWh of Wind Energy
- 44 Million kWh of Biomass
- 20 Million gallons of biodiesel and ethanol





Outcome Results (Highlights) 2007-9

Conserved or Reduced

- 17 Billion gallons of water
- 19 Billion tons of CO2
- 9 Billion tons of CO2 Equiv.
- \$7 Billion in Cost Savings
