## **Regulatory Authorities**

- 10 V.S.A. Chapter 159 Section 6616:
  - Releases of hazardous materials into the surface or groundwater or onto the land of the State are prohibited.



## **Regulatory Authority**

- Waste Management and Prevention Division implements Statute
  - Sites Management Section
  - Brownfields Response Program



#### **Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation**

### **Regulatory Authority-Standards**

- Vermont Groundwater Enforcement Standard
  - $-0.5\mu g/I$
- Water Quality Standards
  - $0.000044\mu g/I$  (consumption of water and organisms)
  - 0.000045  $\mu$ g/l (consumption of organisms ONLY)



## Regulatory Authority-Screening Values

- IROCP/Soil
  - -0.12PPM
- Hazardous Ambient Air Standard/Indoor Air
  - $-0.0018 \mu g/m^3$



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# Regulatory Authority-NO Regulations

- Building Materials
- VTDEC does not regulate building materials and defers all impacted building material sites to TSCA



### **Regulatory Authority-Disposal**

- Hazardous Waste Rule
  - Regulate Waste Greater than 50PPM as hazardous waste.
    - No Landfills in VT permitted to receive Hazardous Waste
  - Regulate Waste Less than 50 PPM as Solid Waste.
    - Two Landfills in VT permitted to receive this waste

#### **PCB Sites in Vermont**

- All Sites Regulated by SMS or Brownfields
  - Spills
  - Sites/Brownfields (buildings, soil, groundwater, surface water, indoor air)
