Connecticut PCB Statutory Requirements

- PCBs are regulated at all concentrations, not only 50ppm and above
- CGS Sec. 22a-463 through 22a-469a
- Disposal 22a-467 includes releases, spills
 - Must have a permit; or
 - Written approval from the Commissioner provided
 - Results in the destruction of PCBs or
 - Is not inconsistent with federal PCB requirements
 - Commissioner may include any conditions he deems appropriate to protect human health and the environment



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Connecticut Cleanup Requirements

ENVIRONMENTAL

- Direct Exposure Criteria
 - Residential 1ppm
 - Industrial/Commercial 10ppm
- GA PMC 0.5ppb
- GA Groundwater 0.5ppb
- Caps/ELURs
